The due date for these quilts has changed to the July meeting. A few things to remember: bring quilt in a brown bag so it's anonymous, quilt must have a label (so I know whose is whose- and required for entry into the quilt show. You can iron on wax paper to cover the label temporarily), I will collect all quilts that will be entered in the show in August and deliver them to the quilt drop off the Friday before the show. If you want to take your own, that's fine also.

Requirements for the challenge:

Find a magazine, NON-Quilty or Crafty. Turn to page 38. Use that page as inspiration for a quilt. Quilt dimensions must relate to the 8 1/2 x 11 size page. So, you can multiply those numbers by 2, 3, 4, 45, etc. to get your finished quilt size.

September may seem like a ways off, but its right around the corner! Janet Fogg will be the teacher, and she is offering any of her available kits, which should include Bear Face, Ice Bear, Quick Brown Fox, Leo (the lion), Dracula, Pepper (the chicken), Zigzag zebra, Tessie (the giraffe), Seymour (the turtle), Good Morning Sunflower, the Great Gerber, Moose Mountain, and the Patriot to be released after September 8. We pay for the price of the kit, and it should be a very fun class! Check her website.

And in October, we will have Joanna Price teach Zendoodling. And what is that? Zen-doodling does not require any previous drawing skills. It's actually based on a series of deliberate pen strokes that build upon themselves to create patterns. After drawing some patterns on paper to warm up, we switch to inking patterns directly onto white fabric. Then we add batting and free-motion quilt over the inked lines with black thread. The whole project could become a pillow top, or a wall-hanging, or? Think about it, who doesn't need more practice! Price is \$25.
