

Needle Case #1

Supplies:

- 2 pieces of fabric each 5" x 10"
- 1 piece of batting 7" x 12" (Warm & Natural works well)
- 2 pieces of wool felt (3 7/8" x 3 3/8")
- 1" piece of Velcro
- 1 decorative button

Directions:

Place fabrics right sides together. On short side, mark 1" from corner on one short side and 1" from corner on the adjacent long side (see diagram below) Connect these marks to form angles on the flap. Stitch with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around all sides, stitching on the line you made for the angle on one short side only. Be sure to leave a 2" opening for turning. Turn and press. Close opening by hand. Top stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from all sides.

Measure $2\frac{3}{4}$ " from both short edges and stitch between top-stitching lines to form 3 sections. Align Velcro pieces and stitch Velcro to lining side of flap and right side of the opposite short side.

Cut 2 pieces of wool felt to fit in center section. Stack felt pieces and stitch to needle case, backstitching on both ends. You may stitch through the center or off-centered to make "pages" of different sizes. Add a decorative button on the flap if you wish.
