

Sewing Machine Cover

Supplies:

22" x 29" piece of batting

22" x 29" piece of fabric for back of sewing machine cover

10 2½" x 29" coordinated fabric strips (width is optional - strips can be any size)

4 pieces of fabric for side ties, each 5" x 10"

Approximately 100" of 2½" binding strips

Directions:

Place fabric for back on table with right side down. Layer batting on top and pin in place. Place first fabric strip right side up in center of batting and parallel to 29" side. Using flip-and-sew method, cover batting with the fabric strips. There will be a small amount of batting showing on each side - trim to a rectangle that measures 20" x 27".

To make ties, fold pieces in half lengthwise so that each strip is 2½" x 10". Sew long edge and one short edge with ¼" seam. Turn and press each piece. Place finished ties on long sides of back 3" from short edge with raw edges even. Pin in place.

Sew binding strips together to create a strip about 100" long. Bind sewing machine cover in same manner as a quilt. Place over sewing machine and tie side ties.
