

Instructions for Reversible Bandana

Need 2 different fabrics

Template made from freezer paper (I like using freezer paper because you can iron it on scraps of fabric and then use the rotary cutter.)

Extra Small is from 7inch square cut on the diagonal (Step 3 .fold in 1 1/2", Step 8 sew 1 1/8" casing)

Small is from 9inch square cut on the diagonal (Step 3. fold in 1 3/4", Step 8 sew 1 1/2" casing)

Medium is from 11 1/2 inch square cut on the diagonal (Step 3. fold in 2", Step 8 sew 2" casing)

Large is from 14 1/2 inch square cut on the diagonal (Step 3. fold in 2 1/2", Step 8 sew 2 1/4" casing)

1. Cut out triangle using the freezer paper template on the 2 different fabrics
2. Put right sides of the fabrics together and stitch a 1/4" seam across the top.
3. Open up the seam and iron it flat. Reference to picture. Fold in corner on both sides and press(each pattern size will have a different fold in measurement)
4. Stitch down 1/4" along each side and then press.
5. Lay right sides together and sew 1/4" along each diagonal.
6. Turn the bandana right sides out and press.
7. Top stitch along each diagonal and across the top.
8. Stitch a line parallel to the top right above where the diagonals start.(each pattern size will have a different measurement for the casing.)
